

While many students of the horse culture of the Indians believe that the horses which stocked the Plains had been left behind by Coronado, others contend that all his five hundred and fifty-eight horses, two of the mares, were accounted for in his muster roll. These latter authorities believe that horses came from settlements stock-raising in Many of them spread Southwest. northward through the normal channels of trade, although Indians acquired many by raids on ranches and settlements.
