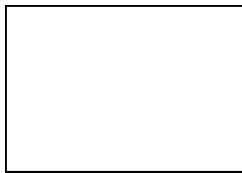


## 420 - "JACKSON'S LEGACY"

1829 Gold was discovered on Cherokee land in Georgia.

The following year the state of Georgia passed a law outlawing the Cherokees from mining the gold. This was the first of several laws that led to the "Trail of Tears"; enforced by Andrew Jackson.

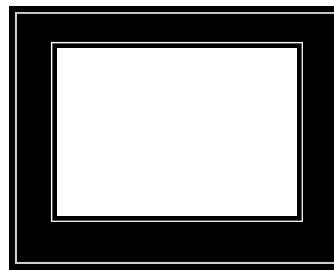

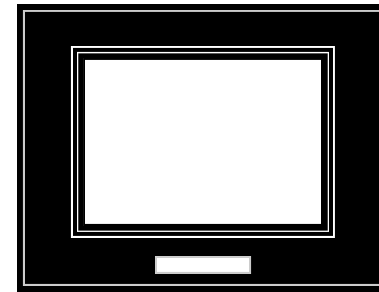
