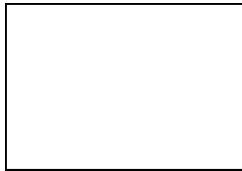




424 - "LEAVING THE BIG PINES"

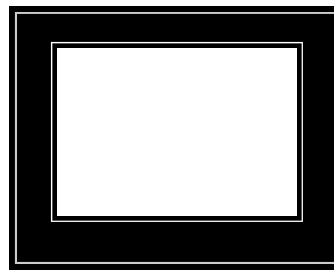

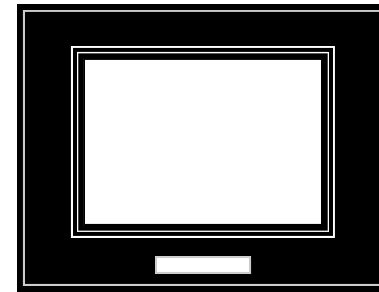
