


RED EARTH 2012 2nd. Place Graphics Winner

From "First Fire" to "Space Walker", Commander John Bennett Herrington, (enrolled member of the Chickasaw nation, born September 14, 1958), was the first Native American Indian Astronaut to go into outer space.

During NASA flight *STS-113* Aboard the *Space Shuttle Endeavor* in November 2002, mission Specialist 2 Harrington docked the space shuttle to the *International Space Station* and became the first American Indian to walk in space during this historic NASA space mission. BATTLE MAP, 1862 - 1865
